Produce songs, beats and jingles, as well as import, repair, process and master audio files. The Editing Suites are also equipped with video editing, compression and graphic tools to process video for digital and online destinations.

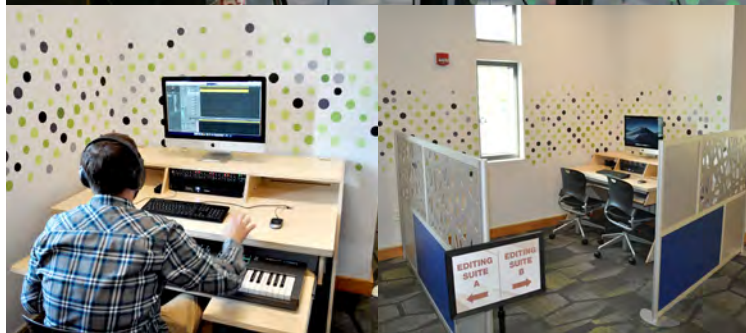

## RESERVING THESE **SPACES**



The **GREEN SCREEN ROOM** (2nd Floor) & **EDITING SUITES** (1st Floor) can be reserved in two-hour increments, with a maximum of four hours per day. Reserve time in advance by calling 937-463-2665. You may make reservations up to 90 days in advance. If available, you may make same-day reservations using the signup sheet at the second floor Ask Me Desk. If there are no other reservations, you may sign up for additional time at the second floor Ask Me Desk. Please note, your reservation may be given away if unclaimed within 15 minutes of the scheduled start time.

## **RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR USE**

For the protection of staff, patrons and equipment, **all patrons are expected to follow the Library Rules of Conduct Policy**; Green Screen Room & Editing Suite users are also asked to abide by the Community Rooms Policy.

To protect the equipment, **NO FOOD OR DRINKS are permitted** in the Green Screen Room & Editing Suites. If you wish to cover the windows for any reason, please contact staff for permission.

A **maximum of FOUR PEOPLE** may use the Green Screen Room at one time. A **maximum of THREE PEOPLE** may use the Editing Suites at one time. One participant must be at least 16 years old and have a Dayton Metro Library card. That participant is asked to stay in the room for the duration of the project.

Due to the public location of the Editing Suites, **no live recording** is permitted.

The last session of each day must end, with projects saved, a **half-hour before** the Library closes.

Please **bring a Flash Drive or Mac-compatible external drive** so that you can save your work. As a courtesy to others, we ask that you allow enough time to save your project before the next person's reservation begins.

Library staff can give you a **5-minute overview** of the equipment. If you are interested in more in-depth instruction, please **schedule a time with a staff member** who will be happy to make an appointment with you. Some proficiency in using computers and recording devices is helpful. Staff may recommend an additional computer class at the Library if they feel that would be helpful to you.
