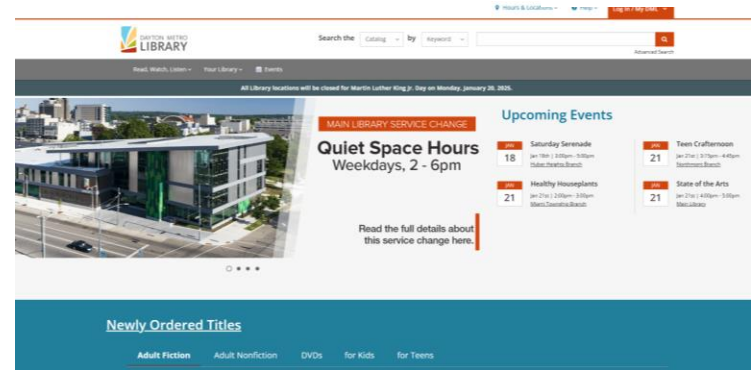




I'm Going to the Dayton Metro Main Library

Before I go to the Library

- If I find information online, I can print it and bring it with me.
- I can call the Library if I have questions at this number: 937.463.2665.



How to Get to the Library

- The Library's address is 215 E 3rd Street, Dayton, Ohio, 45402 ([map](#))
- Before I go, I can look up driving directions on my phone or online.
- If I am taking the bus, I can look up the routes and times online or on the Metro Transit app.
- I can park in the parking garage. The parking garage is on St Clair Street.

I will go to the front of the Library.
It looks like this:



The Library has an “Ask Me Desk” with friendly Library staff who will say “Hello” to me.



This is how I will know if someone works at the Library.
If I need help, I will look for someone wearing an
orange lanyard like this.



This is where I can return things I borrowed from the Library.



This is the Children's Area. It has lots of books, toys, and activities for kids!



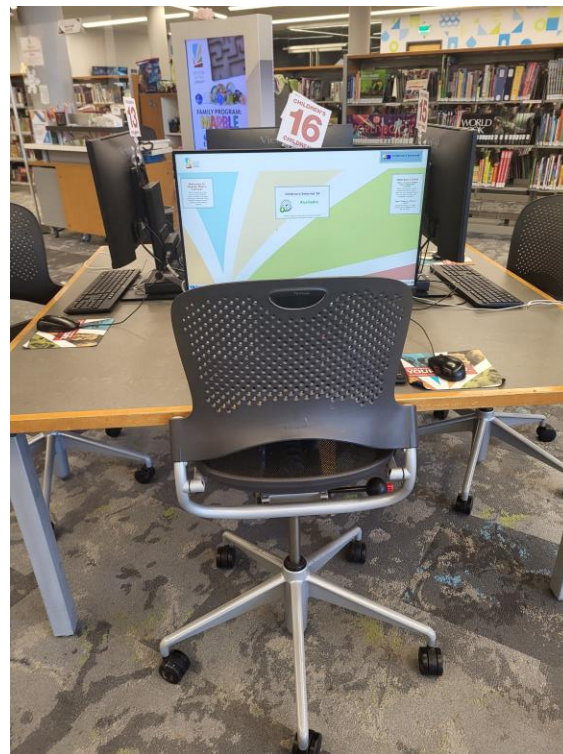
I can ask for help at the Children's Ask Me desk.



There are lots of toys to play with and a bridge I can crawl through.



I can play on the computers.



This is where I can go if I want to join a Library program.



If I need to go to the bathroom I can go here:



If I am not sure where the bathrooms are I can ask one of the Library staff.
Public bathrooms are available on each floor of the Library.

I can visit the teen area for teen programs and books on the 1st Floor.



There are elevators I can use to go to the 2nd and 3rd floor of the Library.



I can use the elevator by pressing this button.



I can respect the Library by not jumping in the elevator.



If I want to learn about local history I can visit this space, the Dayton Room, located on the 2nd floor.



I can find DVDs and music CDs here, on the 2nd Floor.



If I want to find book and audio books for adults I can go to the 3rd floor.



If I feel overwhelmed, I can go to a quiet space or ask a staff member for help.



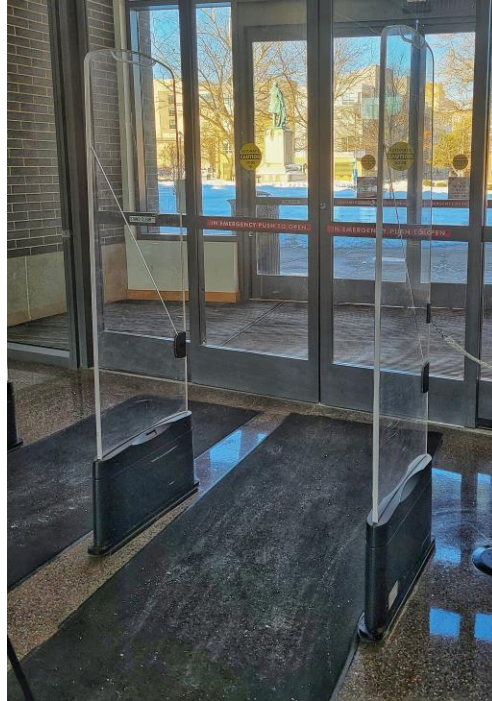
I can use my Library card at the self check out machines to check out items I want to borrow.



If I have a question or trouble checking out, I can go to the Ask Me Desk for help. There is an Ask Me Desk on each floor of the Library.



These are security gates. Sometimes they make a loud noise when people walk through them. If it makes a loud noise when I walk through it, I can go to the Ask Me Desk for help.
