


## I'm Going to the **West Branch** of the Dayton Metro Library

### This is the management team at the West Branch.









If I need emergency assistance, a AED is available behind the Ask Me Desk. This is how I will know if someone works at the Library.


If I need help, I will look for someone wearing an


orange lanyard like this.





## This is where I can return things I borrowed from the Library.






### This is the Children's Area. It has lots of books, toys, and activities for kids!






## There are many toys to play with and coloring pages to color.









I can ask for help at the Children's Ask Me desk.

# Outdoor is a children's patio and a percussion playground.






Our homework help center maintains the planters.




This is where I go to make copies, fax, or email. I can also check out what's going on in the West Branch community!




### This is where I can go if I want to find Branch Program Calendars

## I can visit the teen area for teen books or to play video games.




### I can find DVDs here.

### If I want to look for a specific book, I can use one of the catalog computers, or I can ask a staff member.












If I am with a group of 11 or less, we can utilize the Tech Lab.

### If I want to record my own music, I can explore the Tech Studio.








Dedicated to the late, Joe Madison
