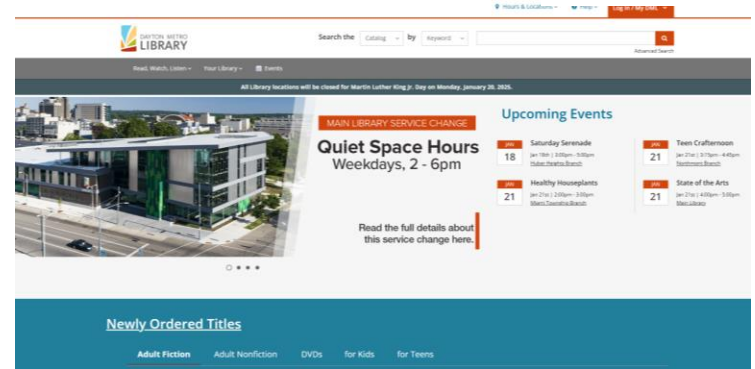




I'm Going to the Northmont Branch of

How to Get to the Library

It looks like this:



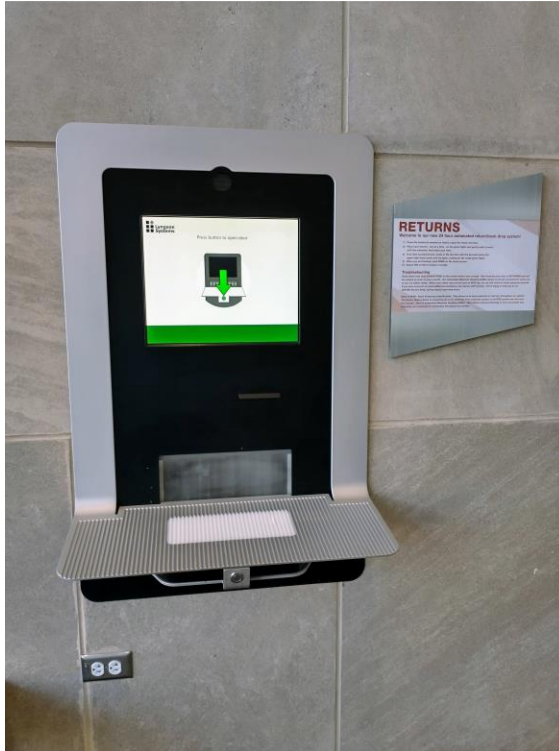
The Library has an “Ask Me Desk” with friendly Library staff who will say “Hello” to me.

There are lots of toys to play with and coloring pages to color.



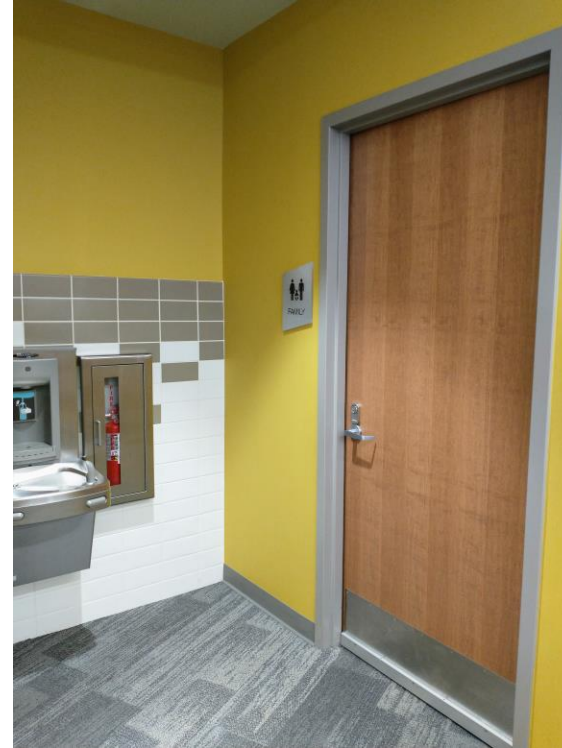
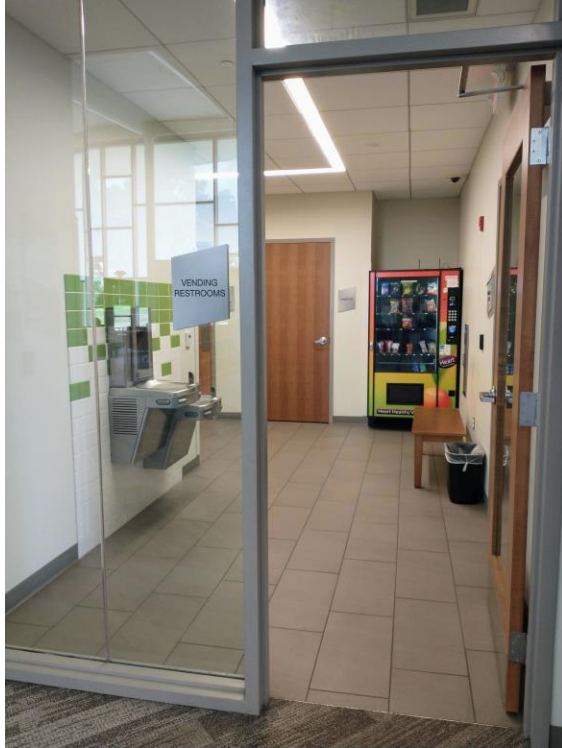
I can use the computers.
