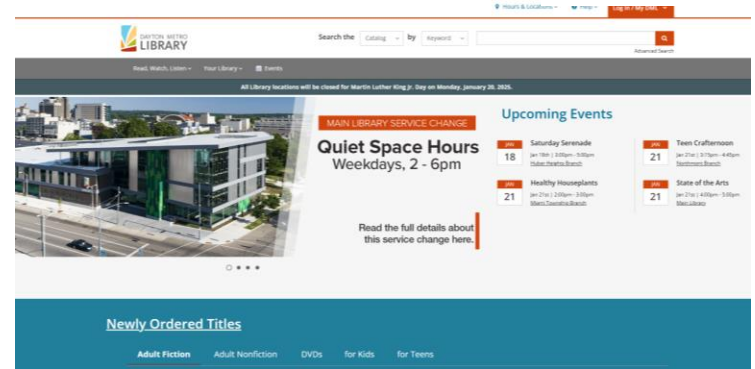




I'm Going to the **Trotwood Branch** of

- I can call the library if I have questions at this number: 937.463.2665.



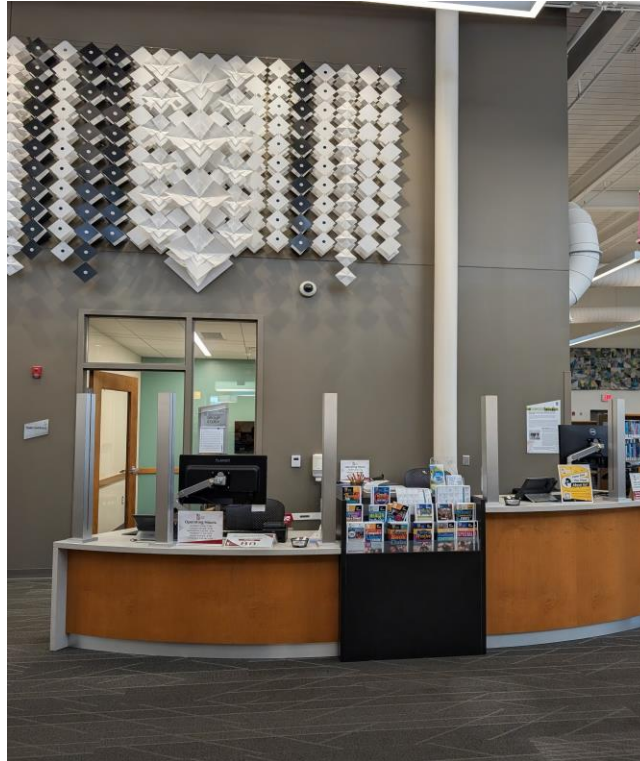
How to Get to the Library

- The library's address is **855 E. Main Street, Trotwood** ([map](#))
- Before I go, I can look up driving directions on my phone or online.
- If I am taking the bus, I can look up the routes and times online or on the Metro Transit app.
- I can park in the parking lot and walk up the walkway to the front entrance.

I will go to the front of the Library.
It looks like this:



The Library has an “Ask Me Desk” with friendly Library staff who will say “Hello” to me.



This is how I will know if someone works at the Library.
If I need help, I will look for someone wearing an
orange lanyard or badge clip like this:



This is where I can return things I borrowed from the Library.



This is the Children's Area. It has lots of books, toys, and activities for kids!



There are lots of toys to play with and coloring pages to color.



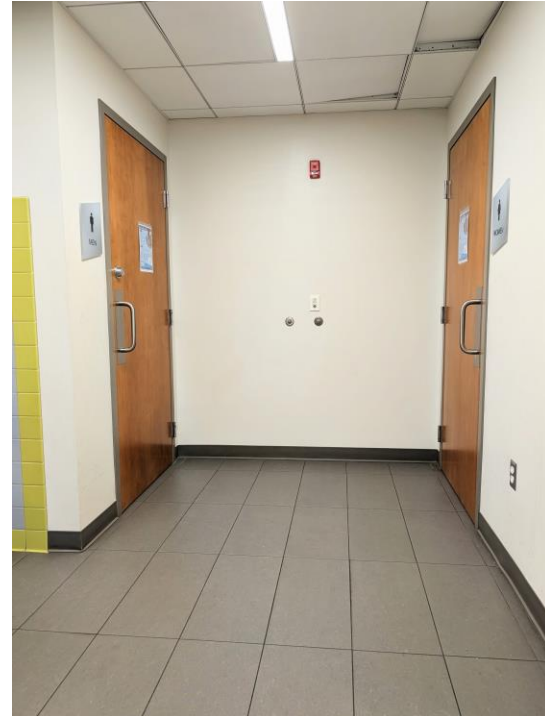
I can play on the computers.



This is the Community Room where library programs are often held.

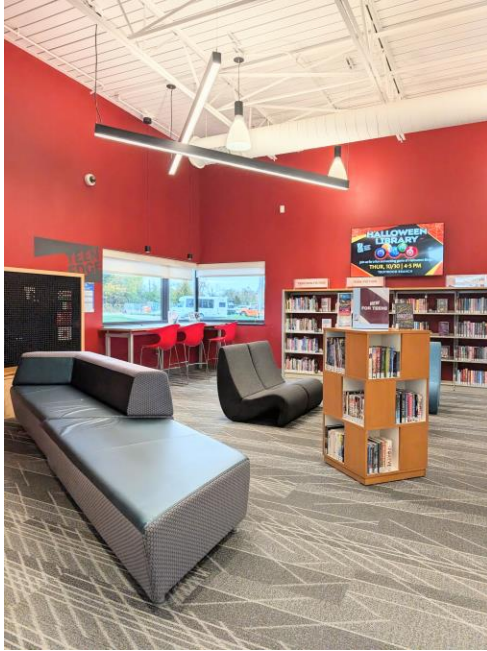


If I need to go to the bathroom I can go here:

I can print from the computer here.



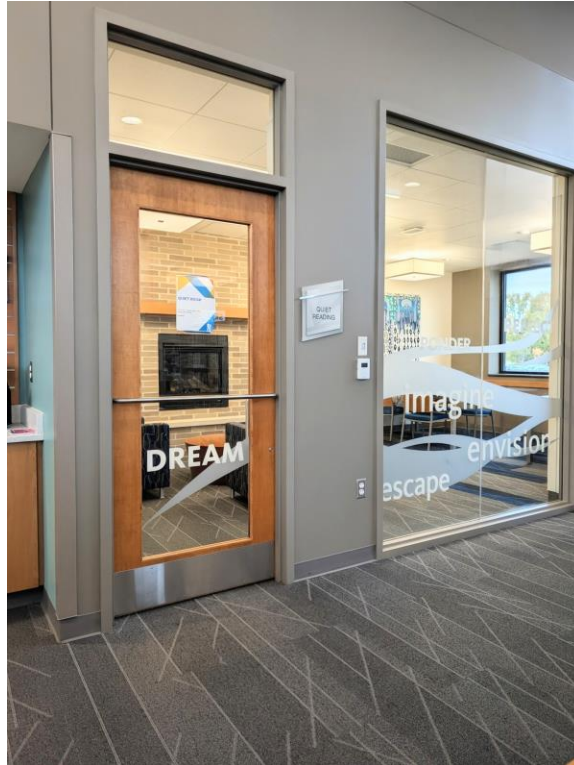
I can find DVDs here.
