


# I'm Going to the **Trotwood Branch** of the Dayton Metro Library

#### How to Get to the Library

• The library's address is **855 E. Main Street, Trotwood** (map)

Before I go, I can look up driving directions on my phone or online.


• If I am taking the bus, I can look up the routes and times online or on the Metro Transit app.

### This is the Children's Area. It has lots of books, toys, and activities for kids!




### There are lots of toys to play with and coloring pages to color.

If I am not sure where the bathrooms are I can ask one of the Library staff.


## I can visit the teen area for teen books or to play video games.

#### I can print from the computer here.




#### I can find DVDs here.



If I want to find book for adults, I can go to adult section.




If I feel overwhelmed, I can go to a quiet space or ask a staff member for help.
